CUA31020 Certificate 3 in Screen and Media COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is designed to prepare students with the basic skills and work ethic to undertake entry level roles in the rigorous and often competitive screen and media industry. During this training students will participate in and develop their own videos using industry-standard software and equipment. In addition, students will be introduced to many aspects of the screen and media industry such as lighting, sound, editing, production, photography, and use of social media as an industry tool. Students will participate in two 2 Day intensive workshops with commercial grade video equipment and cameras in the Brisbane area. Here they will gain hands on experience working in a crew while learning the skills and protocols of working on a film set. Course structure

WEEKLY INTERACTIVE SESSIONS:

Students will be required to attend our fun and informative interactive learning sessions (Via Zoom) consisting of a 1.5-2 hour online video conference each Tuesday and Thursday from 1:15 pm - 3:15 pm for a minimum of 4 hours a week. It is compulsory for all students to attend the online sessions using a Webcam and Microphone. These sessions provide the students valuable opportunities to develop their communication and engagement skills as part of their training for a future in the workplace. It a student is unable to attend a session for unforeseen reasons (such as illness or medical appointments), contact must be made with the trainer via email prior to the start of the session nline attendance falls below 80%, students will be unlikely to receive the Certificate. TASKS: Students will also be required to undertake practical tasks which can be (on average) up to 4 hours each week. Assessment tasks are given weekly. Many of them will be completed in class. All tasks are to be submitted by the due date. The tasks form essential evidence that the student has gained the required skills to complete the course. MANAGE ALL MODIFY Workspace Students should set up a clear and quiet dworkspace with consideration of Government working from home guidelines. To attend online interactive sessions students will need an environment free from distractions, and a computer with an Internet connection. The computer must include audio, a microphone and a webcam. This is very important and is part of your training in meeting the demands of the workplace for this industry. You will be connecting to your learning sessions via webcam, so please ensure your internet connection is stable. It is a requirement of this course that ALL STUDENTS use their webcam and microphone during interactive sessions. Students that decline to use a webcam and microphone will not be considered eligible to continue the course. Webcam and microphone will be mandatory from week 3 onwards. MANAGE ALL MODIFY Work experience in a creative industry Students will be required to participate in at least 10 or more hours of work experience in a creative industry, ministry or activity. This might include activities such as stage sound and lighting, video or production, social media management, photography or other creative industry. Students can arrange this with their local church or community group. Work $experience \ will \ be \ expected \ to \ begin \ during \ \textbf{Term 2}. \ Students \ may \ seek \ assistance \ from \ the \ RTO \ if \ this \ is \ not \ possible. \ An \ and \ possible \ and \ p$ Agreement with the organisation leadership and documentation will be provided for this placement. MANAGE ALL MODIFY Equipment requirements The student must be a currently enrolled student at Faith Christian School year 10, 11 or 12 for 2024. The student will require an internet connected computer with a webcam, microphone, and sound. A camera or smartphone will be required to take photos and videos as evidence of practical tasks completed. Students must attend work experience and two 2-day intensives, to complete this course, IMPORTANT: Students will be required to download some software during the course to complete screenwriting and photo and video editing tasks. We have done our best to find software that is free of charge. Please note that software requires certain computer specs for smooth operation. The suggested minimum spec's for computers is as follows: CPU intel core i7 processor 16GB Ram GPU 4G minimum Minimum Essential Equipment • Stabilisation of some kind (smartphone stand or tripod) eBay or Amazon under \$50 · Headphones (earbuds that come with smartphone are fine as a minimum) • Microphone (if doing interviews or dialogue scenes), you can buy cheap Lavalier mic's \$20 and upward or a more expensive Rode shotgun mic for smartphone for \$110 Amazon or Ebay · Portable Hard drive (for storing files). Portable hard drives can be purchased or under \$100 (Seagate 1TB \$69 on Amazon) or 32G or 64G or higher USB3 Flash drive (\$30-\$50) · Computer with AT LEAST the minimum specs as above. Total approximate cost \$200, not including cost of Smartphone or student's own computer. MANAGE ALL MODIFY Intensives 2 Day Intensives This Course involves two 2-day intensives using commercial equipment in a production studio in the Brisbane Area in terms 1 and 3 (Dates TBC). Students participate in all aspects of shooting a video using industry work practices. Students gain valuable experience in working in teams (crews), collaboration, and in operating professional equipment in a studio environment. Attendance at these intensives is compulsory to complete the course. Accommodation with a local Faith family can be arranged for Faith students from areas outside of Brisbane.
